- Sculpt a Whale

- Form ball of Clay into a cone shape for the body.
- Pinch Clay to form the nose and dorsal fin.
- Pinch to elongate the body and flatten end for tail.
- Use Sculpting Tool to carve tail. Flatten again at end.
- Carve area for mouth and poke to form eyes.
- Flatten a small ball of Clay and cut out flippers with Sculpting Tool.
- Attach flippers with Project Glue.
- · Let dry, then paint.


- Sculpt a Sea Star

- Form Sculpting Clay into basic sea star shape.
- Pinch to add detail.
- Let dry, then paint.



- Sculpt Coral

- Roll a desired number of elongated cone shapes. Flatten bottom for gluing.
- Using tip of Sculpting Tool, mark a crisscross shape on top. Pinch to add detail.
- Let dry, then glue together with Project Glue.
- Form a piece of Clay into a circle shape, let dry, then paint. (Base for coral)
- Glue coral to base, let dry and paint coral as desired.



- Sculpt Sea Plants

- Flatten Clay (approx. 1/8" thick) with a rolling pin.
- Using the Sculpting Tool, draw leaf shapes in Clay. Let set for a minute or two, then cut apart. Add leaf pattern.
- For curved shape, place leaves on dowels while drying.
- · Paint when dry.
- Form a piece of Clay into a circle shape, let dry, then paint. (Base for sea plants)
- Glue leaves to base.
