- Stippling

A stiff-bristle paintbrush is recommended for this technique.


- · Dip tips of bristles in paint.
- · Dab brush on surface repeatedly.
- Apply paint in layers until desired look is achieved.



- Sponging

This technique is great for painting clouds or a forest full of trees.

- Cut a small piece of household sponge.
- · Dip in a small amount of paint.
- Lightly dab on surface repeatedly, making a textured pattern.
- · Continue until desired look is achieved.



- Blending

Blend colors together to create a unique look.

- · Paint an object with a color.
- While paint is wet, add another color.
 Do not rinse brush between colors.
- Blend and dab colors together with a wet paintbrush.



- Drybrushing

This technique is great for weathering a structure. Apply over a painted surface.

- Dip paintbrush tip in a small amount of paint.
- Brush on a paper towel until nearly clean of paint.
- · Brush on desired location.
- · Continue until desired look is achieved.
