



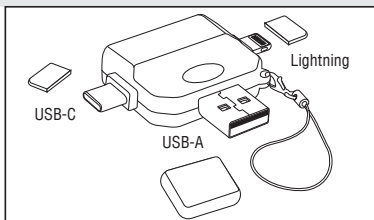

From finding sounds online to recording your own, there are many different ways to get sounds to use with our Just Plug Sound System. One of the easiest is to use the sounds we provide with our Just Plug Sound Studio™, a free sound-editing program available on our website.

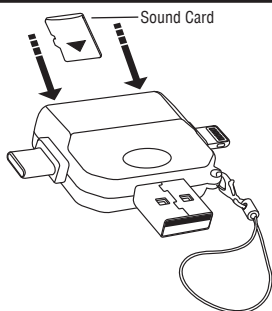


COMPUTER

ADDING SOUNDS TO SOUND CARDS USING THE SOUND STUDIO

1. Go to our website at www.woodlandscenics.com.
2. Navigate to our free tools page, then open the Just Plug Sound Studio app.
3. Insert a Sound Card into the slot on the Sound Card Reader. (**Fig. 1**)
4. Remove the USB caps from the Sound Card Reader
5. Plug the Sound Card Reader into your device.

6. Click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then select new project.
7. Type the name you want the file to be named, then click ok.
8. Click the green add sound button in the top left, then click select from library.
9. Click select a category, then select a category from the options provided to see all of our sounds for that category.
10. You can press the play button to hear what the sound sounds like. If you want to use that sound, click the load button for that sound.
11. Click the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then select save mixdown.
12. Name the file, then click ok to download the converted sound.
13. Locate where on your computer the sound file downloaded to, then move it into the Sound Card's storage.
14. Remove the Sound Card from the Sound Card Reader and insert it into a **Sound Hub™ (JS6904)**. The Sound Card may now be played.

DELETING SOUNDS FROM SOUND CARDS

If you want to add a new sound to a Sound Card, you will need to delete the old sound first since the Sound Hub will only play the first sound file on a Sound Card.

1. Insert the Sound Card with the file you want to delete into the slot on the Sound Card Reader. **(Fig. 1)**
2. Remove the USB caps from the Sound Card Reader.
3. Plug the Sound Card Reader into the computer.
4. Open your files, then open the USB drive.
5. Right click on the sound file, then click delete from the menu that will pop up.

RECORDING SOUNDS

You can use the Just Plug Sound Studio to record your own sounds and add them to a Sound Card.

1. Insert a Sound Card into the slot on the Sound Card Reader. **(Fig. 1)**
2. Remove the USB caps from the Sound Card Reader.
3. Plug the Sound Card Reader into a device with a microphone.

4. Go to the Just Plug Sound Studio, click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then click on new project.
5. Type the name you want the sound to be called, then click ok.
6. Click the red microphone recording button. The Sound Studio is now recording.
7. When you are finished recording, click the microphone recording button again.
8. Click the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then select save mixdown.
9. Name the file, then click ok to download the converted sound.
10. Follow steps 13 and 14 in the first section to add your recorded sound to the Sound Card.

DOWNLOADING SOUNDS

The Sound Card Reader can also be used to add sounds found online or from other sound recording apps onto your Blank Sound Cards.

1. Insert a Sound Card into the Sound Card Reader.
2. Remove the USB caps from the Sound Card Reader.
3. Plug the Sound Card Reader into one of the USB ports on the computer.
4. Locate the sound file you want to use on your computer.
5. Look at the file type. If it is an .mp3, skip to Step 12. Otherwise, follow the following steps to convert your file to a .mp3 file.
6. Go to the Just Plug Sound Studio, click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then click on new project.
7. Type the name you want the sound to be called, then click ok.
8. Click on the green add sound button in the top left, then click select from device.
9. Locate your sound file, then double click the file.
10. Click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then click save mixdown.
11. Name the file, then click ok to download the converted sound.
12. Follow steps 13 and 14 in the first section to add your sound to the Sound Card.

USING THE SOUND STUDIO TO EDIT SOUNDS

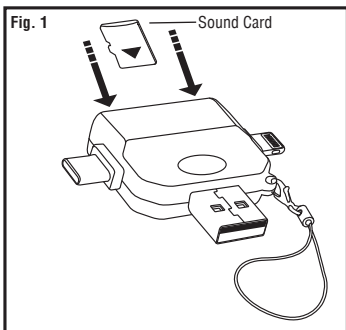
The Just Plug Sound Studio has a variety of tools that allow you to edit sounds to your liking. When using the Sound Studio, click on the ? in a blue circle on the lower right corner of the screen for instructions on how to use any of the tools. Using the Sound Studio, you can:

- Combine multiple sounds into a single sound file that will play on a Sound Card.
- Pan a sound so it will play from the left speaker to the right speaker or vice-versa.
- Adjust the volume of sounds.
- Add a fade in or fade out to a sound.
- Cut out selections of a sound and/or paste them in other parts of the sound.

ADDING SOUNDS TO SOUND CARDS USING THE SOUND STUDIO

1. Go to our website at www.woodlandscenics.com.
2. Navigate to our free tools page, then open the Just Plug Sound Studio app.
3. Insert a Sound Card into the slot on the Sound Card Reader.
(Fig. 1)
4. Remove the USB caps from the Sound Card Reader
5. Plug the Sound Card Reader into your device.
6. Click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then select new project.
7. Type the name you want the file to be named, then click ok.



8. Click the green add sound button in the top left, then click select from library.

17. Select the USB storage option, then copy the sound file.
18. Remove the Sound Card from Sound Card Reader and insert into a Sound Hub. The Sound Card may now be played.

5. Select the USB storage option, then hold finger on the sound file until a checkmark appears.

2. Remove the USB caps from the Sound Card Reader
3. Plug the Sound Card Reader into the phone.
4. Download the sound file onto the phone.
5. Find the my files folder on your phone. From there, the sound file will either be located in audio, videos, or downloads, depending on the app used.
6. Look at the file name. If it ends in .mp3, skip to Step 13. Otherwise, follow the following steps to convert your file to a .mp3 file.
7. Go to the Just Plug Sound Studio, click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then click on new project.
8. Type the name you want the sound to be called, then tap ok.
9. Tap the green add sound button in the top left, then tap select from device
10. Find the sound you downloaded and select it.

11. Tap on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then select save mixdown.
12. Name the file, then click ok to download the converted sound.
13. Follow steps 13 – 18 in the first section to add your sound to the Sound Card.

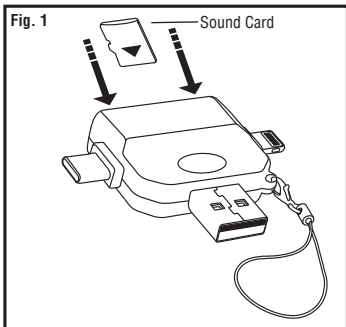

5. Open Safari and go to the Just Plug Sound Studio, click on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then click on new project.
 6. Type the name you want the sound to be called, then tap ok.
 7. Tap the green add sound button in the top left, then tap select from device.
 8. Find the sound you downloaded and select it, then click open.
 9. Tap on the three bars in the upper right corner of the screen, then select save mixdown.
 10. Name the file, click ok, then click download to download the converted sound
 11. Follow steps 13 - 15 in the first section to add your sound to the Sound Card.

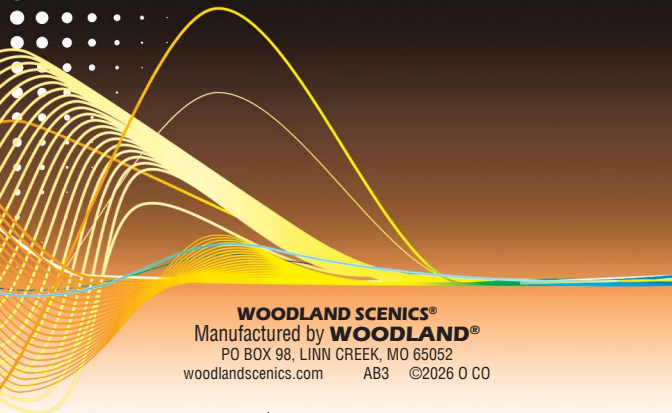
